WINDLE CAMPAIGN COUNTERS POLITICAL PARTY MISINFORMATION

Snoqualmie Pass, WA - In recent days, voters identifying as Democrat and Republican have been told by members of their own parties that they cannot vote for James Windle in the primary, who is an Independent. This is false. The 2004 People's Choice Initiative allows people to vote for Windle, regardless of their party affiliation.

Windle is the only candidate on the ballot for Washington State's 8th Congressional District that will state "no party preference" for the August primary. As an independent candidate, he combines ideas from both the major political parties to provide solutions that will lead to economic growth and job creation.

Windle strongly believes in the ability of voters to choose the best candidate to represent them. "I would not be surprised if a misinformation campaign expands to mislead voters in the weeks ahead," said Windle "This is another example of the political parties underestimating the intelligence of the voters. The old primary system where people can only vote for their party is history. Democrats and Republicans can vote Windle for Congress in the primary."

The People's Choice Initiative established a unique top-two primary election format in Washington State. This format provides Independents like James Windle the opportunity to seriously challenge the Republicans and Democrats. Recent polls suggest that Independents are on the rise with record percentages both nationally and locally - 38% of Americans and 37% of voters in Washington's 8th District.

Windle sounded confident that he is gaining momentum with his candidacy after only a few weeks of campaigning: "Voters have a choice in who represents them. The best person for the job should be elected to office. The parties' monopoly over Congress is about to end with this campaign."
