WINDLE COMMITS TO DAILY LOG RUNNING FOR FINAL WEEK OF THE CAMPAIGN

Snoqualmie Pass, WA –James Windle, Independent candidate for Congress in Washington's 8th District, will be running with his five-foot long, 37 lb. log during rush hour everyday for the last week of the primary campaign. Beginning Monday, July 30, Windle will be running with his log through communities in the 8th District. Voters and Windependents are encouraged to join (no log required but heavy objects, backpacks, and water are encouraged).

The starting time for the run will be 5:00 pm unless otherwise noted. Windle will arrive at 4:30 for press availability. The stops during the Windle coffee shop campaign will be the starting and finishing point for the run. The runs will vary from two to four miles. The routes will be made available in the morning each day on the Facebook page “Windle for Congress”:
